

Event Report - Round 3 - Barkston Heath - 9th June 2013



Round 3 of the series was held at Barkston Heath. This popular sprint track has a smooth surface, tight bends and open straights. The combination of chicanes, long open corners and straights makes it a challenging circuit, with something to test all types of car. Many regular competitors are keen to beat their times from previous seasons.

With a low cloud base, making it cold but dry, competitors signed on and cars scrutineered, the drivers had only to concentrate on setting their fastest time, and staying on the black stuff! As drivers new and old took to the track, there were many screeches of tyres as the track, and strategically placed marker cones, took drivers by surprise.

The break for lunch was soon upon us and the pit lane was busy with mechanics eager to get the cars going that little faster! With battles throughout the field and drivers separated by mere tenths everyone was looking for an advantage. The weather improved and most drivers achieved their quickest runs in the afternoon.

With 12 classes the Toyota Sprint Series really caters for a wide range of both driver ability and vehicle providing a challenge for everyone from the novice to the professional team.

Report & Results in class order:



Class F Pro - Up to 1.0

Debbie Cooper in her 1st year of Toyota Sprint was driving her TRD Vitz, Debbie improved her times throughout the day by over 5 seconds by trying new tactics each run, and took the class win with a 67.16s run on her last outing of the day. The Vitz and Debbie proved hard to beat by a few other cars, showing how Barkston Heath allows cars with lower power to really punch above their weight.



Class D Pro – Up to 1.6 Normally Aspirated

Matt Hopkins and his MR2 were on their own in this class, and by experimenting with braking zones and racing lines had some sporadic times throughout the day. Matt finally found a method that suited the MR2 and took the class win with a 66.43s run on his last run of the day.



Class C Street - Over 1.6 Normally Aspirated

This class saw the return of TSS regulars Dan Quinn and Paul Thomas joined by newcomer Alex Daniel. The battle was mainly between Dan and Paul, with two hundredths of a second separating the leader. Dan's Supra just got there with a 59.63, whilst the GT86 of Paul Thomas could not get his tyres 'in the zone' to beat his time of 59.65 set in the morning.



Class C Pro- Over 1.6 Normally Aspirated

The two regular entrants in this class are having an on-going battle in their well matched cars. This time, the Celica of Chris Girdler took the class win with a time of 58.50, and Ed Stracey taking second place with the Supra's time of 59.55.



Class B Pro - Up To 1.6 Forced Induction

Both regular entrants in this class have been struggling with car issues in the first two rounds, and were hoping for a good day. Times were close throughout the runs, but Phil Cutler's supercharged MR2 finished first with a 56.76. Barrie Newsome delivered a 57.44 in the Starlet Turbo.



Class A3 Street - Over 1.6l Forced Induction

Another close class in terms of cars and drivers. Today, the GT4 of Roger Greaves was the victor with a 61.00, Avi Seebaluck chasing hard in his GT4 and a time of 61.39. This class also saw Anuj Seebaluck share the GT4 with Avi, and our 'furthest travelled driver' all the way from Mauritius. This was the first event for Anuj but he will be back for more.



Class A3 Pro - Over 1.6l Forced Induction - Modified

One of the bigger classes, but dominated by brothers James and John Crabtree in their well set up GT4. Another close battle saw James hit a phenomenal 53.99 in run 5, prompting John to try hard in run 6 and come back with a 54.06. The time set by James also saw him third overall.



Class A2 Pro - Over 1.6 Forced Induction

Another popular class, but the super Celica of Barry Mason was proving hard to beat. Keeping up with Adrian Smith in the Pro Tuner class, Barry delivered a hot time of 52.97 before lunch. The Celica shared by Nigel Levinson and Andy Bunney were having their own battle, and it was Nigel who took the second place with a time of 54.93. no one could bear Barry's time and he took first place overall.



Class A1 Pro - Over 2.0 Forced Induction

Christian Timms and the MR2 were holding up this class single handed, but still had fun chasing the top guys. Christian's time of 55.60 also earned him the Hard Charger award.



Pro Tuner

All alone in the Pro Tuner class this year, Adrian Smith was out in his GT86, but having a battle with Barry Mason in A2 Pro. In the end, despite knocking a few hundredths off each run, Adrian's time of 53.25 could not beat Barry for overall honours, but earned him a well deserved second overall.
